BI Success Story: Centers For Disease Control & Prevention

The CDC has been involved in a Migration from Mainframe to Cluster of HP Machines since November 2008. CDC was retiring an IBM 2064 Model 102 Mainframe, and migrating to a cluster of HP ML370 G5 machines with a HP StorageWorks 8100 Enterprise Virtual Array SANS storage system. The mainframe was used by SAS Programmers, SAS Custom Application

Developers, SAS Custom Application Users, and Analysts. Since SAS was installed on the mainframe, CDC needed to migrate SAS to the new hardware. Special concerns and considerations were security and parallel environments.

Qualex worked with CDC to conduct system test and consider deployment procedures. Qualex concluded that due to the nature and types of jobs being submitted on the mainframe, a batch only mode of job submission

would not meet the current use requirements of the existing mainframe SAS users. By implementing the SAS Intelligence Platform approach, the system would enable the use of many of the SAS Tools such as EG, DI Studio, E-Miner, and the BI Platform.

Finally, Qualex recommended additional SAS software components not previously considered.
